



Privacy Notice When Personal Data is not Obtained from Data Subject

Edge Careers Ltd is a recruitment business which provides work-finding services to its clients and work-seekers. Edge Careers Ltd must process personal data (including sensitive personal data) so that it can provide these services – in doing so, Edge Careers Ltd acts as a data controller.

You may give your personal details to Edge Careers Ltd directly, such as on an application or registration form or via our website, or we may collect them from another source such as a jobs board. Edge Careers Ltd must have a legal basis for processing your personal data. For the purposes of providing you with work-finding services and/or information relating to roles relevant to you we will only use your personal data in accordance with the terms of the following statement.

1. Collection and use of Personal Data

a) Purpose of Processing and Legal Basis

Edge Careers Ltd has collected your personal data (which may include sensitive personal data) and will process your personal data for the purposes of providing you with work-finding services. The legal bases we rely upon to offer these services to you are:

- Consent
- Legitimate interest

b) Categories of Data

Edge Careers Ltd has collected the following personal data on you:

Personal data:

- Name/contact details
- CV

c) Legitimate Interest

Where Edge Careers Ltd has relied on a legitimate interest to process your personal data our legitimate interests is as follows:

- For the purpose of supplying work seeking services

d) Recipient/s of Data

Edge Careers Ltd will not process your data with any third party.

2. Overseas Transfers

Edge Careers Ltd may transfer only the information you provide to us to countries outside the European Economic Area ("EEA") for the purposes of providing you with work-finding services. We will take steps to ensure adequate protections are in place to ensure the security of your information. The EEA comprises the EU member states plus Norway, Iceland and Liechtenstein.

3. Data Retention

Edge Careers Ltd will retain your personal data only for as long as is necessary. Different laws require us to keep different data for different periods of time.

The Conduct of Employment Agencies and Employment Businesses Regulations 2003, require us to keep work-seeker records for at least one year from (a) the date of their creation or (b) after the date on which we last provide you with work-finding services.



We must also keep your payroll records, holiday pay, sick pay and pensions auto-enrolment records for as long as is legally required by HMRC and associated national minimum wage, social security and tax legislation.

Where Edge Careers Ltd has obtained your consent to process your personal data, we will do so in line with our retention policy (a copy of which can be found on www.edgcareers.co.uk). Upon expiry of that period Edge Careers Ltd will seek further consent from you. Where consent is not granted Edge Careers Ltd will cease to process your personal data.

4. Your Rights

Please be aware that you have the following data protection rights:

- The right to be informed about the personal data Edge Careers Ltd processes on you;
- The right of access to the personal data Edge Careers Ltd processes on you;
- The right to rectification of your personal data;
- The right to erasure of your personal data in certain circumstances;
- The right to restrict processing of your personal data;
- The right to data portability in certain circumstances;
- The right to object to the processing of your personal data that was based on a public or legitimate interest;
- The right not to be subjected to automated decision making and profiling; and
- The right to withdraw consent at any time.
